It is vital that all workplaces making use of forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw that can cause injury, damage to machinery or accident.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) Are forklift tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is a yearly forklift certification and inspection done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the required job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different attachments and uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted properly?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to use the machine?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all types of lift trucks being operated?
- 22) Do operators know their responsibilities to report any machine damage and lift truck incidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed each day prior to the machinery being operated?
