

Windsor Aerial Lift Training

Windsor Aerial Lift Training - An aerial work platform is a mechanical access platform. This particular machine provides access to otherwise not accessible places for equipment or people. Also called an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is usually utilized to be able to access high areas. Maintenance and construction staff often have to utilize aerial work platforms on the job. Firefighters make use of them for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is intended to temporary use, providing access to high areas. They are intended to be operated by one person, with the capability of lifting weights of not more than one ton. Several kinds have higher load limits. There are different kinds of aerial work platforms; like for instance, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Many of the aerial work platforms are outfitted together with compressed air connectors for power tools and electrical outlets. For specialist tasks, like for example lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform can come together with special equipment.

Those who would like to operate an aerial lift device have to go through training. Usually, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of every machine and work areas and are likewise required to go through training. Trainees will learn aerial lifting device operation. They would likewise know the rules which apply to safely using these devices. Regulations differ from province to province, and within federally regulated worksites.

Workers who are required to be lifted or work near an aerial lifting device needs to be aware of all the potential hazards. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown in order to educate all of the workers who work near them or are lifted by them.

Aerial Lift Training Program comprises modules focused on the following: Hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The program is intended to train workers on safely utilizing self-propelled, boom supported elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. A certificate will be given to workers who complete the program, signed by a qualified individual to verify the successful completion of a hands-on practical exam.
