Course materials include load exercises and load charts for the crane with which the individual training is working.

Over half of the course consists of Hands-On Safety Training. Practical training is useful for developing and increasing personnel skills levels. Just skilled journeyman crane instructors are selected to teach the courses. Our instructors possess numerous years of experience in the industry.

Optional testing mechanisms are offered for all of our courses. Students will normally write tests both prior to and following training. A skills test is generally administered for programs that comprise H.O.S.T. Trainees will be tested and graded.
