One more common danger is getting hit by falling things. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to incorrect lifting techniques are one more common hazard.

Warehouse machines carries inherent hazards. Accidents or injuries can be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, like pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, need to be used carefully during unpacking, packing and loading.
